1. Official Photography at Club Events

The Club designates a named photographer for each event.

Any gymnast or parent who does not wish themselves or their child to be photographed or filmed must advise the Club at the event so that the Club can take action to ensure any identifiable images of the participant are not published by the Club.

2. Conditions for Personal photography at Club Events

Anyone wishing to take personal photographs must abide by BG rules.

- I. The purpose of videoing, filming or photographing MUST ONLY BE for coaching or family use.
 - II. Flash and /or lighting is NOT to be used because it can cause an accident.
 - III. The person recording the video, film or photography MUST NOT :
 - a) Upload any of these image onto public or social network sites.
 - b) Take or share images of anyone else without their written consent.
 - c) Use, alter or permit the altering of any images in any way for inappropriate use.

3. Personal Photography

British Gymnastics does not wish to discourage the use of video or photographic equipment at events for appropriate use, but will take all reasonable precautions to protect gymnasts against the possible inappropriate use of films or photographic images.

BG Photography Regulations require anyone organising a gymnastic event to regulate the taking of photographs and apply, as a minimum, the BG Conditions for Photography at Gymnastic Events, (see Appendix 1 in BG Photography Regulations). If the event organiser/welfare officer (or authorised representative of the event organiser/welfare officer) suspects inappropriate photography or filming, the officer/organiser should exercise his/her powers under the conditions to request the person to leave the venue and to surrender any film and/or delete any images relating to the event. Any person present at an event who has concerns about images being taken, by any person, should bring them to the attention of the competition organiser or other designated person.
